

Primary Care

Primary care physicians serve as the frontline of preventative and general healthcare. Sansum Clinic's primary care offices for women are composed of highly trained board-certified physicians and include the departments of Family Medicine, Internal Medicine and Obstetrics & Gynecology.

Our primary care physicians coordinate your care among our many highly trained specialists allowing consistent access to comprehensive care for our female patients. Our integrated model is built upon a team approach that brings together physicians, nurse practitioners, medical assistants, nurses and other clinical staff to deliver coordinated care. Primary care physicians are trained to handle all aspects of healthcare for women, including:

Caring for patients with undiagnosed issues (chest or abdominal pain, shortness of breath) Coordinated care between specialties for patients with chronic medical conditions, including diabetes, heart disease and high blood pressure

Obstetrics & Gynecology

Sansum Clinic is proud to offer the most comprehensive **Obstetrics & Gynecology (Ob/Gyn)** services in Santa Barbara. Our board-certified Ob/Gyn physicians and nurse practitioners are devoted to primary care and reproductive medical care for women from adolescence through the child-bearing years and menopause. We offer annual well-woman exams and address other routine women's health services including:

Pelvic exams
Pap smears
Colposcopy
Loop electrosurgical excision procedure (LEEP)
Pelvic ultrasound
Hysterosonogram

In-office, same-day, nursing appointments are conveniently offered for minor concerns such as blood pressure checks and screening for urinary tract infections.



Nurse by Phone

A telephone advice nurse is available to you from Monday through Friday during business hours. An advice nurse can answer your questions and facilitate your appointment needs. Advice nursing staff works closely with all providers to ensure that you are seen in a timely manner according to individual needs, and are frequently able to address problems over the phone.

Healthcare providers are available to communicate with patients in English or Spanish. Each has a personal Medical Assistant (MA) who assists you during your visit and with any follow-up questions for your provider.





Your Healthy Pregnancy

It is not unusual to have questions during your pregnancy. Information regarding a healthy pregnancy and newborn care is at top of mind for expectant mothers.

Sansum Clinic offers an informative early pregnancy seminar to patients before the 20th

da Vinci Hysterectomy

If your doctor recommends hysterectomy, you may be a candidate for *da Vinci* Hysterectomy, one of the most effective, least invasive treatment options for a range of uterine conditions. *da Vinci* Hysterectomy is performed using the *da Vinci*[®] Surgical System, which enables surgeons to perform with unmatched precision and control—using only a few small incisions.

For most patients, *da Vinci* Hysterectomy can offer numerous potential benefits over

traditional approaches to vaginal, laparoscopic or open abdominal hysterectomy, particularly when performing more challenging procedures like radical hysterectomy for gynecologic cancer. Potential benefits include:

- Significantly less pain
- Less blood loss
- Fewer complications
- Less scarring
- A shorter hospital stay
- A faster return to normal daily activities

Early Detection: The importance of finding breast cancer early

The goal of screening exams for breast cancer is to find cancers before they start to cause symptoms (like a lump that can be felt).

Early detection is critical to determining a good outcome for breast cancer. Women are encouraged to have a routine mammogram, an X-ray that examines breast tissue, so any developing abnormalities can be found. At Sansum Clinic, we provide digital mammography services so women are confident they are getting the most advanced breast imaging and screening techniques available on the Central Coast.



Breast Tomosynthesis/ 3-D mammography

We now offer Breast Tomosynthesis, also known as 3-D mammography. This advanced system offers benefits over traditional digital mammography.

Earlier detection While digital mammography has been the most advanced screening technology available, it is 2-dimensional and has limitations. This new 3-dimensional equipment can detect small cancers that may not be seen with traditional 2-D images.

Greater accuracy 3-D mammography results in better survival rates because of early detection.

Decreased recall rates Improved accuracy reduces the need for patients to return for additional imaging tests. There is also a reduction in the occurrence of false positive biopsy readings.

Automated Breast Ultrasound System: Invenia ABUS®

This state-of-the-art ultrasound system provides advanced breast screening for women with dense breasts who may not receive clear test results using routine digital mammography. This ABUS screening can find small cancers that might otherwise be overlooked, supporting early detection for better patient outcomes.

Ask your doctor if an Invenia ABUS screening would benefit you.



All breasts are not the same.

Some are fatty, some are dense and some are a mix. About 40% of women have dense breast tissue. And for these women mammograms alone may not be enough to find breast cancer.

BREAST DENSITY — WHAT DOES IT MEAN?

Breasts are made of fat and breast tissue. Some women have more fat than breast tissue while others have more breast tissue than fat. When there is more breast tissue the breast is considered dense. On a

> mammogram dense tissue looks white. Since masses or lumps also appear white on a mammogram, a suspicious lump may be masked by the dense breast tissue.

Individualized Breast Cancer Treatment Plans

Our breast care team will thoroughly review and discuss your history, risk factors, diagnosis and treatments, and will design a care plan individualized to your needs. We also offer well breast care, breast imaging, mammography, breast cancer prevention planning, educational services, nutritional guidance, and psychosocial support services. Dense breast tissue is linked with an increase in the risk of developing breast cancer.

Invenia ABUS[®] is the only FDA-approved system for breast cancer screening when used in combination with mammography in women who have dense breast tissue and no prior interventions.

Hereditary Cancer Risk & Genetic Counseling Program

Cancer results from mutations, or changes, in a person's genes that usually occur over many years. Recent advances in medical research have lead to the identification of specific gene mutations that may increase the risk of developing certain types of cancer. These abnormal genes can be passed from generation to generation, and a strong family history of cancer may mean that it's the result of an inherited cancer susceptibility gene. It's important to remember that only five to ten percent of all cancers are caused by inherited genetic mutations, and not everyone who carries them will develop cancer.

At the Cancer Center of Santa Barbara with Sansum Clinic, patients have the unique opportunity to meet with a full-time cancer genetic specialist to discuss your concerns and determine your cancer genetic risk. There are many issues to consider before deciding if genetic counseling and/or testing is right for you or your family.

Breast Care Alliance



At the Sansum Clinic Cardiac Rehabilitation Center, our specialists design a personalized program based on your lifestyle goals. With monitored exercise, nutritional and medication counseling, and support from fellow patients, you'll have the tools you need to regain and maintain the active life you love.



In the United States as many as one in four women die of heart disease. Our Cardiology Department is committed to cardiac care for women. Ongoing research and new technology allows our female patients to benefit from the latest diagnostic and treatment techniques in virtually every area of cardiac medicine from research and prevention to detection and treatment.

Complete Suite of Cardiac Services & Specialties

We provide a wide array of cutting-edge heart disease diagnostic testing. Our Echocardiography Lab is the first in the Santa Barbara region to receive accreditation from the Intersocietal Commission for the Accreditation of Echocardiography Laboratories (ICAEL). That means access to the highest standards of early heart disease detection available to women in our community.

Should you require surgery, our board-certified surgeons and staff specialize in minimally invasive interventional cardiology, which results in less pain and scarring and provides faster recovery compared to traditional openheart surgery.

Endoscopy Treatment

A range of procedures are performed including:

Endoscopy to identify ulcers, inflammation, polyps, tumors or other abnormalities that can go undetected by CT scans or MRIs

Colonoscopy to identify polyps and detect early signs of cancer

Endoscopic Retrograde Cholangiopancreatography (ERCP) to assist in the diagnosis and treatment of stones or tumors of the pancreas or bile ducts

Colonoscopy

A colonoscopy is a common screening procedure for colon cancer or rectal cancer. Colorectal cancer is the third leading cause of cancer deaths in the United States. People age 50 and



older are advised to have a colonoscopy every 10 years if they have no special risk factors for colon cancer. If a relative has had colon cancer, or if you have inflammatory bowel diseases such as Crohn's disease or ulcerative colitis, you may get a colonoscopy earlier or more often. If precancerous polyps are found, they can be removed during the colonoscopy.



Urinary incontinence is estimated to affect as many as 50% of middle-aged and elderly women. Incontinence is defined as the involuntary loss of any amount of urine.


There are many treatment options for incontinence. The best treatment for each woman depends on factors such as the type and severity of incontinence, her medical condition and her expectations.



All of our weight loss options use high quality nutritional meal replacements. Mandatory weekly group classes focus on easy ways to lower fat and calories as well as simple strategies to add physical activity and more fruits and vegetables into your daily routine. A health educator helps participants set and reach goals through a structure of personal accountability and follow-up.






