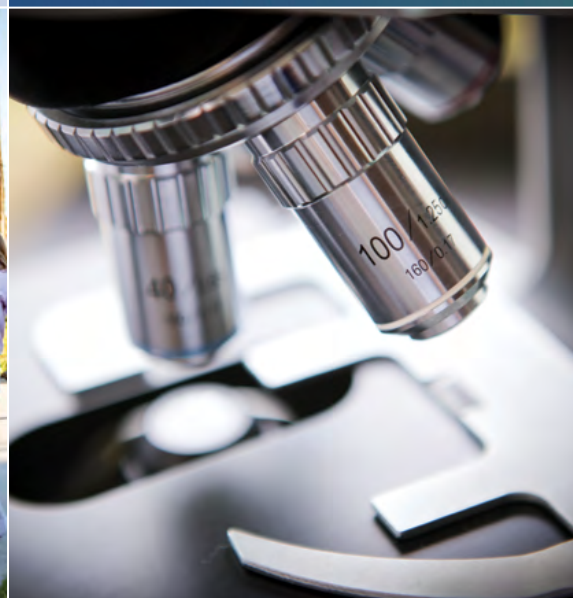

Our steadfast commitment to helping patients with a verified need for financial assistance is one of the strong pillars of our partnership. The **Arthur J. Merovick Endowment for Patient Assistance** surpassed the **\$2 million mark** in 2019, a tremendous testament to the importance of this fund and the promise to ensure everyone in our community has access to the best cancer care, regardless of their ability to pay. Ridley-Tree's cutting-edge **Clinical Research Program** that advances and expands care is funded by the Cancer Foundation and places us on par with major academic institutions. These options for patients are only available because of consistent support from donors and our community partners, like the **Rancheros Visitadores**. This past year, the group exceeded **\$1 million** in contributions to the Cancer Foundation, the eighth on record raising breast cancer awareness and funds in conjunction with its annual Solvang horseback ride and parade.

In addition to our compassionate, highly-trained physicians and staff and world-class technology, our investment in evidence-based **Wellness and Supportive Care Programs** has resulted in thousands of patients finding healing and connection. In December of 2019, the Cancer Foundation joined Ridley-Tree in celebrating art instructor **Rick Stich** for teaching 20 years of his class, **"Painting the Pictures of Health."** Offering respite and relief from the effects of cancer treatment, whether that comes from an infusion nurse, a social worker, a financial counselor or a massage therapist, is powerful medicine. A 2019 grant from **Athena Cosmetics Corporation** supplied patients with cooling caps designed to prevent hair loss during chemotherapy as part of a research study. An expansion of our **Acupuncture Program** provided complementary therapy for those managing treatment-related symptoms. These types of contributions have significant and meaningful impact on those we serve.

We know you have many choices of where to invest your valuable resources and we thank you for choosing the Cancer Foundation of Santa Barbara and Ridley-Tree Cancer Center. Your kindness has allowed us to accomplish a tremendous amount in the course of one year, and guarantees a legacy of excellence that will continue to flourish for generations to come. ●

Ensuring Excellence in Cancer Care

The **Cancer Center of Santa Barbara** and **Sansum Clinic** forged a strategic partnership in 2012 to elevate the level of cancer care available and to build a world-class regional cancer center, **Ridley-Tree Cancer Center**. Out of this union re-emerged the **Cancer Foundation of Santa Barbara**, the financial partner of the Cancer Center since its inception in 1949. For the past 70 years, thanks to the generosity of patients, foundations and supporters, the Cancer Foundation and its trustees have provided steadfast vision, leadership and support to deliver on its mission to ensure superior cancer care is available in Santa Barbara regardless of a patient's ability to pay. What began with a gift from **Elisha Converse** of a one-million volt x-ray machine - one of seven in the country at the time - has grown into more than a half-century commitment to unparalleled cancer care for residents on the central coast.

The Foundation is proud to be the leading non-profit fundraising and grant-making institution dedicated to cancer care in Santa Barbara County. The Cancer Foundation is the leaseholder and largest annual donor to the Ridley-Tree Cancer Center, the leading provider of cancer care in our region. Each year, the Foundation commits a minimum of 85% (up to 100%) of the proceeds from its endowment and fundraising efforts to support cancer diagnosis, treatment, research, technology and support programs at the Ridley-Tree Cancer Center. The remaining 15% may be used to support cancer-related programs in Santa Barbara County. Historically, these have included oncology bench research at **University of California Santa Barbara** and pediatric cancer research at **Cottage Health**. All Foundation proceeds must be used to support cancer care in our community.

While the physicians and staff of the Ridley-Tree Cancer Center continue their diligent work diagnosing and treating those touched by cancer, the Cancer Foundation maintains its singular focus on fundraising and grant making to ensure Santa Barbara remains in the vanguard of cancer care. The Cancer Foundation raises and distributes millions of dollars each year to the Ridley-Tree Cancer Center allowing the Center to deliver a higher level of care than would otherwise be possible in a community our size. ●

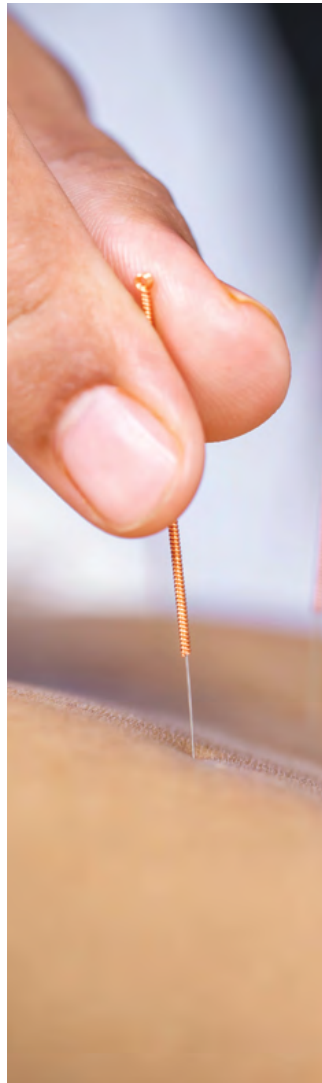

2019 Highlights

Priscilla Higgins, PhD received the 2019 Woman of the Year Award from the Santa Ynez Valley Foundation. Priscilla recently completed her fourth year on the Cancer Foundation's Board of Trustees.



Generous support of Cancer Foundation donors allowed Ridley-Tree Cancer Center to re-launch the **Oncology Acupuncture Program**.



The Rancheros Visitadores topped the \$1M fundraising mark in conjunction with their annual ride. All of the funds raised through their annual fundraising efforts support breast cancer programs at the Ridley-Tree Cancer Center.



Nearly 25 Ridley-Tree Cancer Center staff received funds from the **Toby Ann Parisse Memorial Education Fund** and **Thomas H. Weisenburger, MD Fund** to pursue continuing education related to patient care.



\$286,906 was granted to the Ridley-Tree Cancer Center for the purchase of new infusion chairs for the Ridley-Tree locations in Solvang and Santa Barbara, and the UroNav, MR/Ultrasound guided fusion biopsy system, the next generation of prostate cancer detection.



The Cancer Foundation welcomed **Amalia Priego** to the Board of Trustees.



Named Endowment Funds

*Named Endowment Funds require a minimum of \$100,000 to be established. Toby Ann Parisse Memorial Education Fund

Richard Parisse and his three children honored their wife and mother, Toby Ann Parisse, with a memorial gift dedicated to benefitting the patients at the Cancer Center by funding continuing education for physicians, nurses and staff, an expression of gratitude to the medical teams who cared for Toby throughout her valiant 21-year battle with breast cancer. The **Toby Ann Parisse Memorial Education Fund** was formally dedicated in 2011.

Arthur J. Merovick Endowment for Patient Assistance

To honor Art Merovick's extraordinary contributions to the Cancer Foundation as its Director of Development for 17 years, the Cancer Foundation Board of Trustees unanimously approved the creation of the **Arthur J. Merovick Endowment for Patient Assistance** (AJM Endowment Fund) and a \$500,000 match from the general endowment to provide financial assistance to patients with documented need for medical services. A generous gift of \$200,000 from the Merovick Family launched the fund.

Elizabeth McEwen Jacobs Endowment Fund

The **Elizabeth McEwen Jacobs Endowment Fund** is dedicated to medical or scientific research related to genetic cancer with primary emphasis on brain cancer, and equipment and research of brain cancers in the Tri-Counties. The fund was created in memory of Beth Jacobs by her family and friends after she lost her battle with brain cancer.

Elvira Broome Doolan Endowment Fund

The **Elvira Broome Doolan Endowment Fund** was funded in 1991 from the estate of Elvira Broome Doolan and is restricted for research. She was a patient at the Cancer Center and her husband, Jerome Doolan, was a trustee.

AJM Endowment Fund Surpasses \$2 Million Milestone

One of the core aspects of the Cancer Foundation's mission is to ensure access to today's best cancer care for everyone in our community regardless of their ability to pay. Ridley-Tree Cancer Center's capacity to deliver on this commitment was strengthened in 2011 with the establishment of the **Arthur J. Merovick Endowment Fund for Patient Assistance** (AJM Endowment Fund), created in honor of Art Merovick for his many years of service to the Foundation. Through the generosity of Art's family, friends and members of our community, the AJM Endowment Fund surpassed the \$2 million mark at the end of 2019. As the need for this charitable support continues to grow, the extraordinary success of the AJM Endowment Fund enables the Cancer Center to continue providing the finest cancer care to patients who are unable to cover the cost of their treatment or who are not adequately covered by Medicare and insurance.

Julie Main Endowment Fund

The **Julie Main Endowment Fund** is restricted for wellness exercise programs for patients. Julie was a trustee of the Cancer Foundation, founder of the Well-Fit Exercise Program and instrumental in organizing the annual Cancer Center Walk/Run. The fund was created in 2009 with funds raised from the Main Event, a celebration of Julie's life.

Nan Cox Endowment for Lung Cancer Research

The **Nan Cox Endowment** is earmarked for lung cancer research protocols performed by the Cancer Center, often in concert with other research institutions. The fund was established by Wilbur K. "Bill" Cox in memory of his wife Nancy Clare Finch Cox ("Nan") who was a Cancer Center patient who passed away from lung cancer in June of 2000.

Scott D. Smith Memorial Fund

The **Scott D. Smith Memorial Fund** is restricted for colorectal screening and prevention programs. The fund was created in memory of Scott Smith by his parents, Mr. & Mrs. P. Gene Smith, and their family through the donation of real estate in Fallbrook. Scott lost his battle with colon cancer and his family wanted to support early screening and detection.

Mary Solis Fund for Oncology Social Work

The **Mary Solis Fund for Oncology Social Work** was created in recognition of Mary's 34 year career in oncology social work at the Cancer Center. Proceeds support the programs and services that ensure psychological, social and financial stresses associated with the diagnosis and treatment of cancer are addressed.

Thomas H. Weisenburger, MD Fund

The **Thomas H. Weisenburger, MD Fund** was established to recognize Dr. Weisenburger's retirement in 2012 after 28 years of service at the Cancer Center of Santa Barbara. Proceeds support the education of medical personnel and the acquisition of radiation oncology equipment. ●

Cancer care is often expensive and leaves many Santa Barbara residents unable to afford potentially life-saving treatments. Support of the AJM Endowment Fund means that world-class care offered by the Ridley-Tree Cancer Center's medical team will continue to be available to everyone in our community who faces a cancer diagnosis, allowing them to focus on their recovery without the burden of the inevitable accompanying financial challenges.

In 2019, the Cancer Foundation provided \$169,472 from the AJM Endowment Fund for financial support of more than 970 patients. Thank you to all who have supported this effort, allowing us to continue to deliver on our commitment to the Santa Barbara community. ●

The Power of a Planned Gift

Yvonne Baker Heltman was born in January of 1924. The only child of Emmitt Baker and Vera Rasor, she grew up in Carpinteria in a small, two-bedroom home a few blocks from the ocean. At the young age of 16, Yvonne purchased the house from her mother for “\$1 plus love and affection” and became a meticulous caretaker and record keeper of the family’s finances. While working as a secretary for the Carpinteria Lemon Association, she met her husband, **Bruce Heltman**, and the couple married in 1945. Cancer impacted Yvonne’s life in many ways. She lost both her mother and husband to the disease two weeks apart in 1982. Yvonne received her own breast cancer diagnosis two years later, resulting in a mastectomy performed by longtime Sansum Clinic surgeon and former Cancer Foundation trustee **Ronald G. Latimer, MD**. In the 1990s, Yvonne was treated by breast surgeon **Rosa Choi, MD, FACS** for several procedures. Inspired by the care and compassion she received, the **Cancer Foundation of Santa Barbara** was Yvonne’s charity of choice. A private person, she always declined Foundation event invitations but she stayed well-informed about the Foundation’s efforts to advance cancer care in the local community.

Without any children of her own, Yvonne designated the Cancer Foundation as the sole beneficiary of her estate, making a decision that will have a lasting impact for generations. *“It is rare that a person will select us as both the executor and trustee of their will, however Yvonne had great foresight in making such a generous gift,”* noted **Lori Willis**, the Foundation’s Executive Director. *“She trusted us with all of the finances that she had independently and carefully tended for most of her life.”* Yvonne’s lifestyle was not extravagant and she was a savvy investor without the help of an accountant or stock broker. When Yvonne passed away in 2018, the value of her estate had tripled from the time she changed her will to include the Cancer Foundation. The sum total of her real estate properties, stocks, bank accounts and jewelry is a significant donation towards ensuring the best treatment, technology, research and critical programs are available at Ridley-Tree Cancer Center. Yvonne is an important example of how all kinds of people can make legacy gifts that not only allow their cherished values to live on, but may even save a life. ●

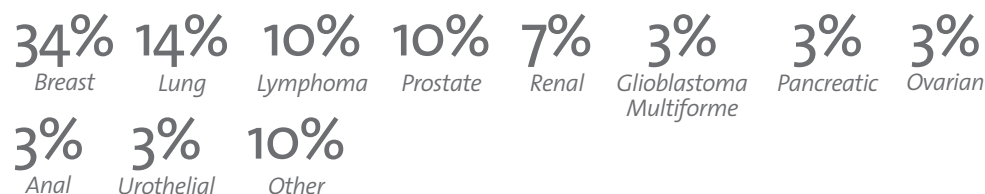
The Cancer Foundation funds the following programs and services to ensure that local cancer patients receive care for their specific medical, psychological, social and logistical needs.



Clinical Research

Ridley-Tree Cancer Center leads the community in cancer research, participating in an array of global studies alongside other major medical facilities. This includes providing our patients with access to the most current treatments on clinical trials at leading cancer centers and academic centers around the country.

Top Cancer Types in Trials:



Genetic Counseling

The Genetic Counseling program offers hereditary cancer risk counseling to help patients and families with a history of cancer better understand and manage the risk of developing cancer through genetic risk assessment and genetic testing. In 2019, the department achieved a 15% increase in average monthly referrals as a result of greater community outreach efforts.

719 Patients were seen for hereditary cancer risk counseling

525 Patients pursued genetic testing and follow-up genetic counseling



Prevention & Community Outreach

The Ridley-Tree Cancer Center partners with other community agencies to coordinate outreach programs and events to improve public understanding of the importance of early detection and prevention of cancer, as well as developments in diagnosis and treatment.

32 Symptomatic patients received diagnostic colonoscopies

264 Youth attended Raising Awareness Yields Sun Safety (RAYS) youth skin cancer prevention program

Ridley-Tree Cancer Center's patient navigators provide valuable care coordination and education to patients and families, offer support at times of transition in care and act as liaisons between individual patients and their various healthcare providers. In 2019, the number of patients navigated increased by 15% to include patients with more complex needs.

Patient Navigation

The Cancer Center's oncology dietitian nutritionists provide evidence-based food and supplement recommendations to patients to correct nutritional deficiencies and help optimize nutritional health and well-being during and after treatment. In 2019, Sarah Washburn, MS, RDN, CSO presented the Nutrition department's Fitbit Device Study at the San Antonio Breast Cancer Symposium, the country's premier breast cancer conference.

Oncology Nutrition

The Oncology Social Work team is dedicated to helping patients with psychological, social and financial stresses associated with the diagnosis and treatment of cancer. This includes individual and family counseling, case management, support groups, assistance with home care and long-term care, insurance, transportation, finances and advocacy.

Wellness Programs ♧

The Wellness department offers many programs that complement conventional medical care for patients and their caregivers. Programs include yoga, exercise programs tailored for all phases of treatment, painting, flower arranging, meditation and more.

Resource Library & Educational Programming 📖

The Resource Library offers a comfortable place where patients and families can find current, comprehensive information about all aspects of cancer. Our library manager helps answer questions, offers research assistance and also provides staff with scientific medical literature that is in support of our evidence-based approach to care. Additionally, this department organizes free educational programs for the public. Community Lectures provides patients, caregivers and community members an opportunity to learn about current topics in cancer care and prevention.

This event is dear to Barbara Ireland, who lost a friend to breast cancer in 2000. All proceeds from this event directly support breast cancer research, genetic counseling and patient navigation services at Ridley-Tree Cancer Center. With a special Kick-Off event at Dargan's Irish Pub & Restaurant, the playful connection between St. Patrick's Day and breast cancer awareness remains stronger than ever. The **Spirit Award** was granted to **Barbara Fabian**, and **Save Second Base** was awarded the **Pink Ribbon** trophy for being the team that raised the most money. This event has raised **more than \$900,000** since its inception.

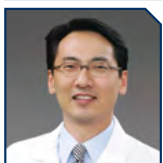
George C. Cheng, MD, PhD

Christopher Martinez's Story

Christopher Martinez was determined not to let chemotherapy interfere with his daily exercise routine. The Lompoc firefighter started his daily six-mile run and 500 push-ups at 4:30 am to avoid the sun, following a recommendation from his medical oncologist and hematologist **Mukul Gupta, MD**. Sometimes Christopher would run accompanied by fellow firefighters, friends or family, but most of the time he would push through alone, wrestling with his thoughts, fighting off nausea and fatigue. Christopher knew this physical activity would help him tolerate the chemo, but it was also his way of coping. *"I wanted to prove to myself and others that mentally we can get through anything in life – even cancer and a six-month chemo regime. I was determined to be stronger from this and turn my cancer diagnosis into a positive,"* explains Christopher.

A colon cancer diagnosis in May of 2019 came as an incredible shock for the 44-year old in impeccable health. Unusual blood work results discovered during an annual screening required by the Lompoc Fire Department set in motion a series of tests. Sansum Clinic's **David Phreaner, MD**, Martinez's primary care doctor, had given Christopher a clean bill of health just eight months prior during a yearly physical exam. The changed picture over a short amount of time was puzzling. Dr. Phreaner referred Christopher to Sansum Clinic gastroenterologist **Vincent DeRosa, MD** for a combined endoscopy and colonoscopy. Those procedures and a subsequent biopsy confirmed Christopher had stage II colon cancer. The 2018 exam

done by Dr. Phreaner would prove to be an important reference point for Christopher's care team in tracking how his cancer had developed quickly with no symptoms, and in a non-smoker with no family history of cancer – except that he was a firefighter.

The next step in Christopher's cancer journey would require the knowledge and skills of surgical oncologist **W. Charles Conway, MD, FACS**. Dr. Conway's attention to detail and welcoming, caring manner put Christopher at ease and he patiently answered many questions from Christopher's wife, **Xochitl**, and sister, **Laura**, both nurses at Cottage Hospital. *"He listened to all of us,"* says Christopher. *"It was a big weight off my shoulders."* Dr. Conway successfully removed a large portion of Christopher's colon, along with 46 lymph nodes, and predicted the firefighter's overall health and fitness would help him to recover well, which he did. Post-surgery, Christopher and his family took time to choose an oncologist and selected Dr. Mukul Gupta. Christopher appreciated the lengthy consultation with Dr. Gupta that helped them understand all of the important medical information and research which drove his treatment recommendation for the oral chemotherapy drug, Xeloda®. *"I felt like he gave me the opportunity to feel empowered in the decision-making process,"* notes Christopher.

Once the treatment plan began, the personal attention from his regular care team including nurse practitioner **Erica Koeppen, DNP** and medical assistants **Elizabeth Cuevas** and **Kathy Judy** made Christopher feel at home during his visits. Patient navigator **Sam Howland** commanded logistics, which he thought especially helped when the brain fog from chemo kicked in. *"Sam's response was always, 'no problem',"* he relays. Sam introduced Christopher to the multidisciplinary approach purposely incorporated into care at Ridley-Tree Cancer Center, and all of the people and services he could access. Oncology nutrition dietitian **Sarah Washburn, MS, RDN, CSO**

outlined the symptoms he might experience from the chemotherapy, and assisted with a personalized diet as Christopher's sense of taste began to change. Having lost his mother as a third grader, Christopher battled the emotional weight of seeing his eight year-old daughter, **Luisa** process his illness at the same age. Oncology social worker **April Calderon, MSW** met with Luisa several times to work through the stress of having a parent with cancer. Luisa told her father that it was helpful to talk with someone who understood what she was going through. *"I was not going to leave my daughter. Sorry, not happening,"* Christopher reiterates with his characteristic steely resolve. *"But*

sometimes dealing with cancer, your kids take a lot of that brunt. Ridley-Tree supported that aspect so I could focus on recovery.”

Christopher's firefighter family contributed funds and placed blue Colon Cancer Awareness stickers on their engines among many actions to support him. But it was the department-sponsored physical exam that saved his life. His Lompoc colleagues could not make sense of how their *"healthy hippie"* – who they would tease for his University of California, Berkeley education, choice to drive a Prius and mainly plant-based diet – could be the one to have cancer. Firefighters face an increased risk of cancer compared with the general public because of their exposure to carcinogens on the job.

Today, Christopher is in remission and has returned to work, but is now a passionate cancer awareness advocate for first responders and the importance of annual physical exams with blood tests. He wants other cancer patients to know if they choose Ridley-Tree Cancer Center for their care, they are in great hands. *"I got an A+ team and I am completely blessed to have this care in my backyard. If you have cancer, this is the perfect place. They are going to set you up for success."* ●

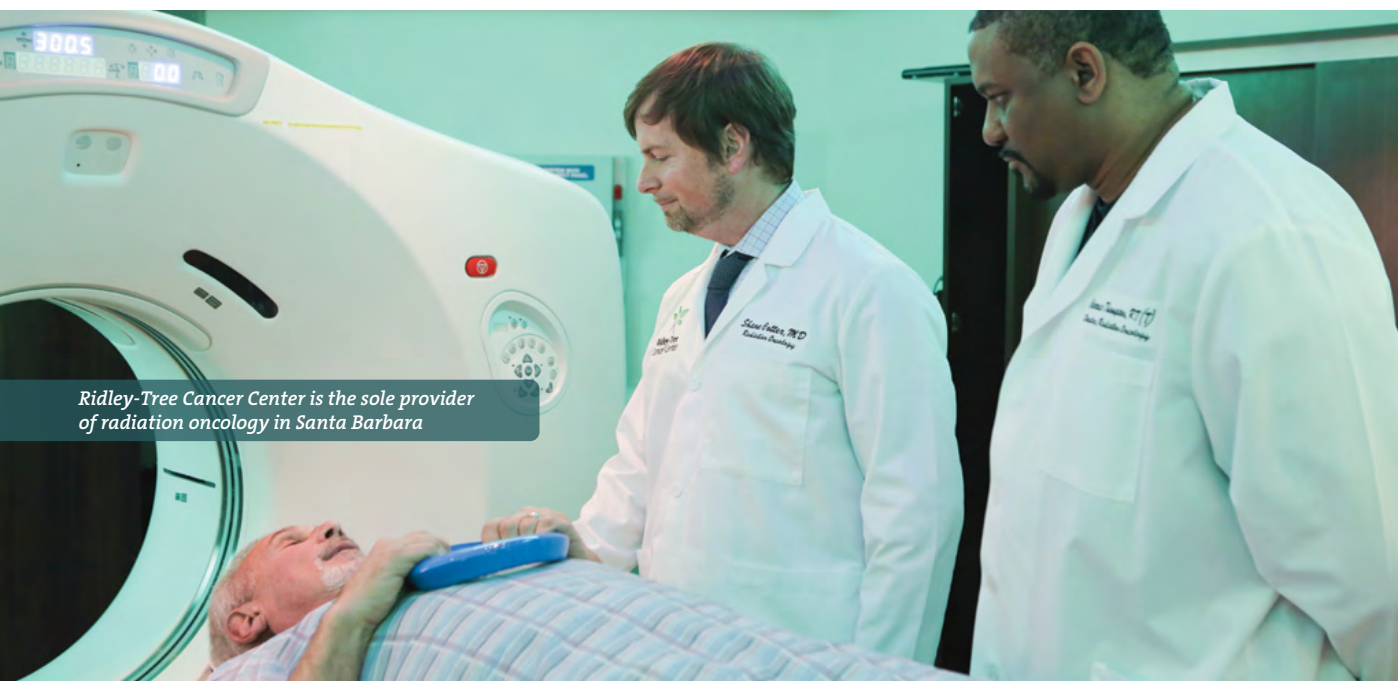
